Allergy Season (Prescription, Inhaler, and Non-Prescription Medicine Reminders)

Please note that Engleside does not stock allergy or congestion medications for students. As we move into allergy season, please remember that any medication including inhalers that your child needs to take at school must be presented by the parent to the office (or to the AM care supervisor for those enrolled in this service) in a clearly labeled *original* container. Before ECS can administer any medications, we must have a *fully completed* Medication Authorization Form on file. Documentation for prescription medications must also include the physician's authorization either by signature or by note. For your convenience, ECS has a link to our Medication Authorization (Parent-Physician-Provided Medicines) Form on our website. Blank copies are also available in the office.
