Attendance Reminder

ECS requires parents to notify the school office by phone or email at the start of the school day any time a student is absent. If students are leaving early or arriving late due to an appointment, parents must notify ECS one day in advance. For any other planned absences, parents must notify ECS (both the office and the child's teacher) as soon as possible.

Cold and Flu Season Reminders

Any child showing symptoms of illness should remain at home. ECS cannot permit any student with a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher into the classroom. *Children must be fever and symptom free for at least 24 hours apart from medication before returning to the classroom.*
